LIGHTWEIGHT SPORT RIFLE OPEN MEETING

Carshalton Rifle Club, Saturday 22nd October 2016

General Information

Classification: Precision Competition to be shot in two classes. The number of competitors in each class will be determined by the entries received so as to achieve similar numbers in each class.

The responsibility for declaring an accurate average rests with the competitor.

All competitors will be classified according to their submitted average; to be based on the best 4 of the last 5 confirmed 30 shot precision competition scores.

SCSBRA reserves the right to reclassify any competitor if in the sole opinion of SCSBRA it is considered that an incorrect average has been submitted.

Data Protection Notice: Some of the information that you provide on this form will be entered on a personal computer for the purpose of administration of the Championships, distribution of results, and notification of future events. Results will be displayed on the SCSBRA website, (www.surreysbra.org). Individuals on this website will be identified by Name & Club only.

Prizes: Trophies will be presented to the Precision Competition winner. Medals will be awarded in each class proportionate to entries received. Presentations will take place at the County Dinner.

Competitions (Based on the NSRA Rules and Regulations 2011)

Competition 1: Individual 20yd Standing Precision (60 shot match)

This will be fired in two relays of 30 shots, each comprising 1 sighting series, (unlimited sighters), of 5 minutes, plus 3 competition series of 10 shots fired in 10 minutes per series. Two 5-round magazines may be loaded during 'loading time' and both used during each series. Larger capacity magazines are allowed, but a maximum of five rounds may be loaded at once. This may require a re-load during the 10 minutes shooting-time.

Competition 2: Junior (Under 21 years of age on the date of the competition). (*As per Competition 1*)

All competitions: Competitors must choose on the entry form the two relay times that they wish to shoot.

Point deduction penalties apply for loading or firing more than the permitted number of rounds in any competition.

All shooting will be done on PL14 targets at 20 yards

Range Command summary

Guns must not be removed or returned to cases without the instructions of the Range Officer.

There will be 5 minute preparation time before each Precision relay. Dry firing, sighting and aiming exercises may be performed during the preparation time. On the command 'LOAD' there will be a 1 minute loading time before each series. Magazines must be inserted and shooters ready to fire at the end of that time. On the command 'ATTENTION' the targets will be edged, the shooter must adopt the 'READY' position, (*butt in shoulder, barrel <45 degrees from horizontal*), and remain stationary until the targets turn. Firing may begin when the targets turn to face the shooter. On the command "STOP, UNLOAD", magazines must be removed and emptied, guns proved clear to the Range Officers and placed on the bench or in a case or rack before the range can be declared safe to score targets. **Guns must not be touched until the next command to load.**

Equipment Control: Competitors will be required to submit their Rifles and equipment to Equipment Control before shooting. These must comply as follows: Lightweight Sporting Rifles with a self-loading or bolt action or air or CO2 rifles of calibre 5.5mm (.22in) or less are permitted. The trigger must be capable of supporting a weight of 500g without discharging. The overall weight, including sights and all other accessories, and including, if used, a glove, shall not exceed 4.5kg. (NSRA rules 8.3.3.1 and 8.3.3.2).
